Our beautiful, loving and endearing mother, Patsy Lozano Osuna joined our heavenly Father December 25, 2022. She was born August 26, 1929. She was one of nine siblings born to Antonio and Hortencia Lozano. She along with her family began their early life as migrant farm workers during the late 1930's and throughout the 1940's. Their work took them from Texas throughout the Country including Wisconsin and Michigan. She enjoyed reading as a young child and would often help the family navigate their migrant farm work travels because she was the only one with the ability to read a map. As a migrant farm working family, at times, they would have to sleep on the side of highways under the night's sky and stars if they were not able to reach their destination during the day, since lodging was not always permitted for migrant farm workers. She would attend school whenever they returned to San Antonio and was able to complete 8 years of education. She was wise beyond all measures nonetheless. She met and then married our father, Robert R. Osuna, in 1949. Together they would have and raise four children, Blanche, Robert, Carl, and Edward. She would grace the family with beautiful Mexican Culture traditions and cooking that would always bring the family together. She was the Grandmother to 6 grandchildren, namely Monica Cook, Melina Garza, Robert Osuna III, Edward A. Osuna, Carlos F. Osuna, and Karenina H. Osuna. She also had 9 Great Grandchildren, namely, Shawn Mungia, Steven Mungia, Diego Narezo, Sophia Narezo, Isabella Narezo, Ethan Baker, Emily Baker, Robert Osuna, and Jeffrey Osuna. She is survived

by sister Margie Ruiz, brother Jaime Lozano, and sister Janie Lozano, and all noted Children, Grandchildren, and Great Grandchildren including spouses of each, namely, Debbie Osuna (Robert), Nina Osuna (Edward), Toby Cook (Monica), Suzanne (Robert Jeffery), and Carina Osuna (Carlos).
