



## Paul Duane Taylor

November 13, 1939 - June 27, 2018

Paul Duane Taylor of San Antonio, Texas, passed away peacefully, at home on June 27, 2018.

Duane was born in Odessa in 1939, son of Velma and Sam Paul Taylor. He was known for his integrity, and acquired his strong work ethic early in life when he began throwing papers as a young boy. At the age of 14 he proudly purchased a brand new automobile, and helped to support his family. Following high school, he served in the Navy as an Air Traffic Controlman aboard the USS Ranger. In 1966 he graduated from The University of Texas at Austin, married Barbara Ann Anderson, moved to San Antonio and enjoyed a highly successful career in Certified Public Accounting.

Duane's passion for sports was unquestionable. He was an ardent fan of Texas Longhorn Football and he could rattle off statistics at the drop of a hat. If you ran into him, more than likely he would be wearing a burnt orange shirt. He fervently watched the Dallas Cowboys, the San Antonio Spurs and loved following his granddaughters' softball endeavors. Duane enjoyed visiting Las Vegas, often joking about being born on a craps table. He was Jack Daniel's whiskey connoisseur and a longtime Tennessee Squire. He had a great sense of humor and whenever asked how he was doing; the likely response was "Just like Tony....T-riffic!"

He was a devoted father and grandfather, and will be missed tremendously by his son, Brandon Duane Taylor, daughter Lori Phillips, son-in-law Greg Phillips, granddaughters Taylor and Allison Phillips, as well as numerous other family members and a lifetime of friends.
