



Pauline T. Jackson

April 27, 1918 - August 6, 2004

Pauline Theresa Jackson went peacefully to the Lord on August 6, 2004 in San Antonio, Texas. She was preceded in death by her husband, Hubert Glencairn Jackson, and is survived by her loving brother, Henry who lives in Monterey Park, California. Pauline, born on April 27, 1918, was the last of five children born to Joseph and Annie Michalka in Cameron, Texas. She graduated from Cameron High School in 1935 and went on to earn a nursing degree from Seton Nursing School in Austin Texas in 1939. After graduation, she worked at Seton Hospital until January 1942 when she joined the US Army. During World War II she supported the Pacific campaign. She was assigned to the 172nd Station Hospital in Australia where she served with distinction in the East Indies, New Guinea, Leyte and the Southern Philippines. After the war, she was placed in the inactive reserve from 1946 to 1948 during which time she worked at the McCloskey VA Hospital in Temple Texas. In 1948 she re-entered the military, this time in the Air Force. She served at various Air Force bases in the United States, Morocco and Libya until her retirement at Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland AFB, Texas in 1965. During her career in the military she achieved the rank of Lieutenant Colonel and received many awards including the Bronze Star. After her retirement, she and her husband made San Antonio their home. "Polly" as she was known,

was a

very supportive and active member of St. Brigid Catholic Church from its beginning until health limited her activities. She was much loved by those who knew her and will be greatly missed.
