Pauline S. Morris, age 96, died in Brentwood, TN on June 14, 2010. She was born on October 7, 1913 in Daingerfield, Texas; moved from East Texas with parents William N. Tracy and Mary Jane Tracy after childhood to San Antonio, Texas; and graduated from South San Antonio High School in 1931. She was united in marriage with her late husband, Percy M. Morris, on December 22, 1933. They were married for almost 65 years before his passing in 1998. A member of the South San Antonio Baptist Church for over 58 years, she is believed to have been the oldest surviving member.

Pauline worked for the Bexar Metropolitan Water District from 1959 to 1976 in South San Antonio. In 2000 she moved to Tennessee to be closer to her daughter, Paula Arrington.
