



## Pauline Christine Villarreal

December 24, 1935 - May 4, 2024

Pauline Christine Villarreal, a life-long resident of San Antonio, went to be with her Lord on May 4, 2024 after a brief illness at the age of 88. She was surrounded by her family and loved ones at the time of her passing.

Born December 24, 1935, she attended Fox Tech High School where she was a member of the Red Jackets dance team. Shortly after graduation, she married the love of her life, Rudy, in 1954.
