Paulino Conde Arguijo Sr., born in Pleasanton, June 22, 1920, died October 13, 2008 at the age of 88. Paulino resided in San Antonio and devoted his life to Luduvina Leal, his wife of 59 years and their only child, Paulino L Arguijo, Jr.

In 1942, Paulino entered the Army and served with distinction during WWII in the 9th Infantry Division as a platoon sergeant. During his service, he fought at the Battle of Normandy and was awarded the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, and his unit received five Battle Stars.

He is preceded in death by his parents, his wife Luduvina, and numerous loved ones. Paulino is survived by; son Paulino Jr. and wife Stella, grandchildren Paul and wife Laura, Sonya and husband Erik Frederick. Great-grandchild, Gabrielle Arguijo and numerous loved ones.
