December 14, 1914 - April 11, 2006

Christine Collins passed away on Tuesday, April 11, 2006 in Austin, Texas. She was born on December 14, 1914 in Delmar, a farming community in the Ozark Mountains of Arkansas. She was the eighth of eleven children born to Lavona Sims and William Sisco. Christine lived and worked for over a decade in Chicago, Illinois. She was employed for many years at Fifth Army Headquarters in Chicago, where she met her late husband, Joseph T. Collins, marrying in 1948. She and her husband became residents of San Antonio, Texas in 1952, where she lived for most of her life. She was an active member of St. Gregory's Catholic Church for nearly 40 years. Christine was generous, kind and fair-minded. She was a natural teacher, teaching at a one-room school house in the Ozarks, coordinating religious education for her church, and tutoring for many years. She was always a nurturer, being sensitive to children and older relatives, and caring to small animals. She loved art, music, and enjoyed being in nature. She was talented as a painter, and highly skilled with many forms of needlework. Christine is survived by her daughter, Catherine Kubelka and husband, Eugene of Austin, TX; son, John Collins and wife, Julia of Independence, MO; sister, Aldine Gibbs and husband, Thomas of Ft. Myers, FL; and granddaughter, Julie Kubelka.
