



## Pedro Barrientos

August 15, 1930 - February 10, 2017

Sergeant Pedro “Pico” Barrientos, 86, passed away on Friday, February 10, 2017 in San Antonio, Texas. A veteran of the Korean Conflict, with Fox Company 2nd Battalion, he was awarded the Purple Heart and the Korean Service Medal w/Star.

Pedro was born on August 5, 1930 in Eagle Pass, Texas to Pánfilo and Plácida Barrientos. He was preceded in death by his parents and three siblings, Alicia B. Martinez, Enrique and Roberto Barrientos.

Pedro served in the Marine Corps from 1949 to 1952. Pedro graduated from St. Mary’s University in 1958 with a B.S. in Geology and a minor in mathematics. In 1962 he earned a B.A. in Psychology. He served as a math teacher at various high schools, a case worker, counselor, Manpower Trainer, Bexar County Juvenile Probation Officer and donated his time to various charitable organizations.

He is survived by his daughter Elizabeth Ann Ibarra, four grand-children, six great- grand children; his siblings Carmen B. Hernandez, Ana B. Gonzalez and Josefina R. Barrientos, five nephews, six nieces and numerous grand-nephews and nieces.

5:00 – 8:00pm, with a mass to be held at St. Matthew Catholic Church on February 22 at 9:00 a.m. with burial immediately following at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery.
