He married his second wife Mary Theresa in 1993 and they resided near his children who had settled in Seattle. In 1995 he and Mary returned to live in San Antonio and never looked back. They were inseparable and enjoyed their time together until Mary's passing in 2010.

Pedro was a humble man who loved his family, his children, his friends and to live life to its fullest. He was a proud veteran who was always grateful for the opportunities this country gave him. His wit and sense of humor were unmatched and will be greatly missed.
