Pete Delgado Barcenez went to be with our Lord on Tuesday, December 28, 2021, at the age of 70. He was born on May 19th, 1951, to Margarito S. "Pete" and Mary Delgado Barcenez in Floresville, TX. The Barcenez Family later moved to their permanent home in San Antonio, TX where Pete graduated from Harlandale High School in 1969. During high school, Pete played football for Harlandale High School and was a bull rider in the rodeo. Upon graduation, Pete joined the United States Air Force during the Vietnam Conflict. He achieved the rank of Sergeant and retired honorably in 1976. After his military service was completed, he started a career with the United States Postal Service. During this time, Pete married his high school sweetheart, Mary, and they began a family. He was an active member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, and VFW Post 4815.
