Peter Lindner Marshall, age 57, passed on Friday, November 24, 2017 surrounded by his adoring wife, family and friends. Peter was born in Houston, Texas. His impressionable years were spent on his family's Escondido Ranch riding dirt bikes and in jeeps, fishing hunting and tending his Father's Charolais cattle in Karnes City, TX.

Peter's career was in custom home building in Houston and San Antonio. He was chosen by Southern Living Magazine as the Idea Custom Home Builder in San Antonio, and was recognized and received numerous awards for building, interior design and tree preservation both in San Antonio and Houston.

In the last seven years, Peter had begun a new endeavor, constructing and building water ponds throughout the Eagle Ford Shale. He loved being in the Oil Patch and he loved the people, particularly the little cafés with all the beautiful stories of the rich history and family lives.

Peter loved the life in the country and in 1994, he and his wife, Patricia sought a Hill Country lifestyle for their children whom they so dearly love.

Peter's Father was a decorated WWII P-47 Thunderbolt Pilot and he pursued a lifelong passion of studying all he could about WWII history. He was a large

Lover of Life and a Visionary and he is described by his family and friends as a most genuine person, a leader and a mentor – everyone mattered to Peter. No one was ever a stranger to Peter. He was very active, loved being Outdoors – fishing, hunting and boating and his other interests and loves include motorcycles - ideally Ducati and motorsports; he shared these loves on to his daughters by teaching them BMX racing and reveled in their achievements.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Samuel Fair and Rebecca (Quirin) Marshall, his brother, Samuel Fair Marshall, Jr. and his ever-loving companion, “Chip – The Wonder Dog”. Peter is survived by his wife of 33 years, Patricia Marshall; his children, Peter “Pete” Marshall, Jr., Mary Anne Elizabeth “Annie” Marshall and Claire Michelle Marshall; his devoted sisters, Mary Marshall and Rebecca “Becky” Hanna and her husband, Edward “Ed”; his brother, William “Neyle” Habersham Marshall; loving nieces and nephew; his great nieces and nephews; his loving and faithful friends; and his four-legged children, Lola “Sandy” and Max.

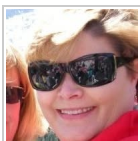

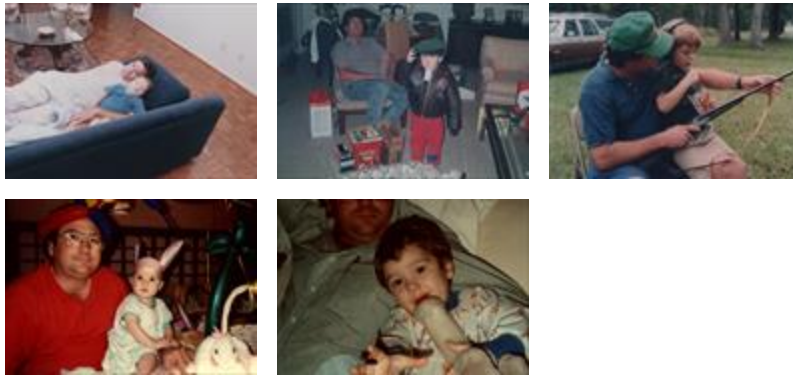
