RAFAEL MACAYA'S OBITUARY

October 11, 1957- January 8, 2025

Rafael Macaya was born in León, Spain, the third child of Luis Macaya and Inés Hernández de Macaya. At three months old, the family immigrated to South America to join his father, a veterinarian who oversaw a large cattle ranch in Colombia. His younger sister, Cristina, was born in Bogotá, Colombia. When Rafael was eleven, the family migrated again, this time to Caracas, Venezuela, where Rafael and his siblings completed their education in various fields. Luis, the oldest, became a metallurgic engineer; Inés Mary, an English teacher; Rafael, a computer engineer; and Cristina, a civil lawyer. His mother was a top salesperson and trainer at Encyclopedia Britannica.

Rafael did well academically at the prestigious Simón Bolívar University, and before graduation, he secured a job with PEQUIVEN, the chemical branch of the state oil company PDVSA in Venezuela.

While working on a special project for PDVSA in Charleston, West Virginia, he met and married Anita Northrup, who was his English mentor. They moved to Caracas, Venezuela, where their daughter, Melissa Eleni, was born. Rafael's work as a high-level manager in the oil industry eventually took him to Maracaibo, Venezuela, where the family flourished until Hugo Chávez came to

power. The political instability led the family to leave Venezuela and start a new life in San Antonio, Texas.

Rafael became an entrepreneur with a clothing alteration franchise called La Retoucherie de Manuela, a business he ran for several years before selling it. He then worked briefly at Dillard's in La Cantera, where his sunny personality earned him clients as far away as Mexico City. His health eventually kept him at home until his passing.

Rafael was best known for his friendly, boisterous, and impactful personality. Anyone he met was not a stranger for long. He was the life of the party, and laughter followed him wherever he went. Even a brief encounter left a happy memory for those he met along the way.

He was a devoted father who doted on his daughter, Melissa, giving her constant support, encouragement and unconditional love. He was a supportive husband and friend with the rare ability to converse on any subject. He cared deeply for his family—his mother, two sisters, and brother. Even though he was far from them, he made it a point to call often and looked after their welfare. He quickly became a beloved Tío Rafael to a myriad of nieces and nephews, both from his blood and chosen family. He was a caring boss and co-worker who treated everyone like family. Along with his wife, Anita, they were known for hosting multiple family members and friends.

His sudden passing from a heart attack has left those who knew and loved him at a loss but his joyous presence and light will always be with us. He had an irreplaceable personality and will be greatly missed. May he rest in peace, and may God bless his soul.
