



## Ralph Alder Roseland

May 4, 1921 - January 5, 2007

Ralph Alder Roseland, Sr., went to be with the Lord in God's perfect timing on January 5th. "Rosy", as he was affectionately called, was born in San Antonio, TX, May 4, 1921. He was preceded in death by his parents, Bert A.
