Ralph Villafranca passed away on May 14, 2019 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on September 5th, 1928 in Yoakum, TX. to Albert Villafranca and Beatrice Fernandez. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Blanche Rodriguez Villafranca, his sister, Mary Louise Villafranca, and his brothers Albert and Ernest Villafranca. Mr. Villafranca is survived by his daughter, Teresa Ann Mays & husband, Robert; grandchildren, Madison & Megan Mays; son, Ralph L. Villafranca.

Mr. Villafranca was a member of the US Army, 1946-48, and a graduate of the University of Texas, 1952 and also attended a Seminary to work toward becoming a Priest, that did not take place.
