



## Ramon Cervantes

August 25, 1929 - August 3, 2020

Ramon Orejel Cervantes (Pa), 90 years old of San Antonio, TX, passed away on August 3, 2020, of natural causes. He was born August 25, 1929 to parents Eliodoro and Rosalia Cervantes in Gary, Indiana. However, Ramon was raised in Michoacán, Mexico. He married Guadalupe Anguiano Cervantes on December 5, 1948. Ramon Cervantes is survived by eight children, Raphael Cervantes, Consuelo Cervantes, Carmen Gamez, Ramon Cervantes Jr, Raul Cervantes, Guadalupe Devlin, Rolando Cervantes, and Carolina Martinez. He was predeceased by his wife Guadalupe Cervantes and daughter Rosario Cervantes.

Ramon Cervantes spent his early years laying down railroad tracks in most of south Texas for the Union Pacific Railroad Company, until he eventually started his own business. Under his own initiative, Ramon taught himself to repair televisions and ran his own business until he retired. He lived out the rest of his years on the southside of San Antonio, where he enjoyed his weekly visits to the VFW for some music and entertainment.
