Ramon Douglas Johnson II, age 54, of Kansas City, Missouri, passed away peacefully on August 30, 2025, at 4:00pm, in San Antonio, Texas, surrounded by his family and loved ones.

Ramon was born on August 14, 1971, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Sharon Williams and Ramon Douglas Johnson.
