



Randy James Fulton

June 21, 1954 - January 27, 2025

Randy James Fulton passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones on January 27, 2025, at the blessed age of 70. He is reunited in Heaven with his parents John D. and Dolores J. Fulton, Richard and Joan M. Ackerman; grandparents John C. and Edith Mae Fulton; and brother Blake C. Fulton. Randy was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and a cherished friend whose spirit touched the lives of everyone he met.

Randy was born in Elyria, Ohio on June 21, 1954. He spent his entire childhood in Ohio and was a standout athlete throughout his high school years, graduating from Lorain High School in 1972. His love for bowling was particularly remarkable— he achieved the incredible feat of winning two perfect games and countless tournaments throughout his bowling career, a testament to his precision and dedication to the sport. Randy also enjoyed playing softball, where his competitive nature shined brightly on the field.

Randy's commitment to service extended beyond the bowling alley and the field; he honorably served in the United States Air Force, embodying the values of duty, integrity, and respect. He was in the last draft held in 1972 and previous to receiving a draft notice enlisted in the USAF in November 1972. After basic training he attended technical training school at Keesler Air Force

Base, where he graduated 9 weeks before the class was slated to end and also received a green rope signifying leadership in his field, electronic intelligence. Randy possessed an EBI Top Secret Cryptologic clearance, the highest clearance possible during his enlistment. Following his military service, he transitioned to a civilian position within the United States Government, where he dedicated 35 years of his career, ultimately retiring as the Chief of Aircrew Operations at Brooks City-Base. His time in the military not only molded his character but also deepened his love for his country.

Randy dedicated a significant portion of his life to community service. He served as a board member for the CYO and took on coaching roles for both softball and volleyball at St. Margaret Mary's. Additionally, he found fulfillment in participating in the Toys for Tots program and contributing to local animal shelters.

Over the last fourteen years since his retirement, he has enjoyed spending time with his wife, children, and grandchildren. To those that knew him, he was regarded as a true friend who would go out of his way for others. He cared deeply about his family and those fortunate enough to call themselves his friends.

Randy is survived by his beloved wife of 21 years, Gloria Lara Fulton of Floresville, TX; his daughters Diahann M. Fuentes (Marques) of Castroville, TX and Melanie M. Ruiz (David) of Boerne, TX; his sons Adrian W. Hubbard (Patricia Polendo) and Andrew P. Hubbard of San Antonio, TX; sisters Terri J.
