Ray Edgar Denison passed away on July 29, 2020 at the age of 100. Ray was born in Eagle Pass, Texas on August 18, 1919 and spent most of his life in San Antonio, Texas where he raised his family and cultivated countless friendships. Ray married Peggy Elaine Jones in 1941, and then shipped out as a Merchant Marine in WWII. He was honorably discharged after serving in both the Atlantic and Pacific theaters.

Ray is preceded in death by his wife of 75 years Peggy, his son Patrick, and his son-in-law Jack Spruce.
