As a boy growing up on a farm, he was interested in FFA and 4H Club. He was a State Champion 4H Club hog raiser in 1935 winning a trip to the National 4H Club Congress in Chicago. During World War II he worked for the Arm Exchange Service at Camp Robinson Ark. When the war was over he went to work for International Harvester Co. and retired after 31 years of service. The last ten years of service he was manager of the IH sales and service store in San Antonio TX. He was a member of Castle Hills First Baptist Church and active in the Nursing Home ministry and a member of the Prayer Chapel. He was a 32^o mason and a 50 year member.

He is survived by his Grandson Michael M. Elmore & his wife Tracy.
