Ray Jean Park, 86 passed away on March 4, 2012 after a long battle with Parkinson's. Ray was born to Dan and Henrietta Park on June 3, 1925 in San Antonio. After graduating from Harlandale High School, he served in the US Navy in the Pacific campaign. After the war, he graduated from the University of Texas and received a Master of Mathematics degree from St. Mary's. He worked for Security Services and served as a Major in the USAFR until his retirement in 1983. Ray was instrumental in establishing SSFCU and served as board president for several years. He was a charter member of the UT Die Hard fan club and a lifelong Longhorn supporter. He was a 60 year member of Harlandale Masonic Lodge 1213, math professor at San Antonio College and member of Shepherd King Lutheran Church. He is preceded in death by two brothers Larry and Gordon. He is survived by Jean, his wife of 54 years, son Mike and his wife, Laurie, daughter Patricia and her husband David, 6 grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren, 2 nephews and 2 nieces.
