Raymond Lee Giles was born on February 4, 1977 to parents Barbara and Kenneth Giles. As soon as Ray started walking he insisted on dressing himself and his favorite choice was a white long sleeved shirt, jeans with belt, and boots! In 1981 Ray moved to San Antonio with his Mom and big brother, Waine. Ray enjoyed sports and outdoor activities with the his Pa, Granny, Uncle Gary, Aunt Dot, and of course the cousins, Chris, Stephen, and Jason at “The Ranch”. Ray was taught how to build roads, cut down cedar, drive a real Jeep, shoot a gun, hunt, and camp out from his Pa and Granny. The work ethic and lessons learned from his Pa and Granny benefitted him and set a high standard for his whole life.

While attending school, Ray always participated in the football, basketball, and track programs and was happiest while competing. Ray became a Mustang car fanatic and owner, having four. Being mentored by Mike Murillo of Texas Jam, Ray’s license plate was “JAMMED” on his first Mustang. Ray attended Texas Tech University and graduated in 2003 with a BA Communications, in the top quarter of his class. Upon graduation, Ray moved back to San Antonio, got his Real Estate license and started Superior Apartment Locating with his lifelong friend, Kevin Taylor. He then opened Q Bar in partnership with Dr. Robert Hartford. After the bar closed, he focused on real estate, obtaining his Brokers License and operating RLG Real Estate until 2019.

In April, 2007, Ray and Katrina Aleman welcomed their first child, Kennedy Lee Giles and in September 2008, welcomed Madison Taylor Giles.

Raymond's girls became the inspiration and motivating force for many long term goals. Ray worked with Kennedy in track and provided piano lessons for Madison for a short while. He wanted them to believe they could achieve their goals through hard work, dedication, and goals. Many conversations with the girls focused on their long term goals. Ken and Madi were his pride and joy and all his plans and commitments included them.

Ray got along well with many people and loved being with his friends and family. He considered himself a king of the grill and loved cooking for his family and friends. He was detailed oriented and always very neat in appearance with fine jewelry, shoes and shirts. His work attire was always a stiffly starched long sleeve shirt, stiff starched jeans with western boots, with his priority always being well groomed. Ray would work out at gyms regularly and was proud of his muscular physique. Ray liked quality products and everything he had was what he considered the best. He was an excellent driver at high speeds and drove his white BMW in a road rallies with the Dust Ball Rally group. His love of fast cars transferred to his Red Ducati motorcycle which he also drove really fast. He spoke of driving it at 196 mph and how he learned to put his knee down on the pavement on the curves making use of his knee pads. He was always knowledgeable about the latest tech product and if it was worthy, in his judgement, he would own one as soon as it became available. Ray loved to travel and was privileged to visit Santorini and Míkonos in Greece, and Paris, France, in September, 2018, with Verenia Ohanian for two weeks, and then their next trip was to Negril, Jamaica, in September, 2019.

In 2017 and 2018 Ray had legal conflicts which were the most difficult hurdles he would have to overcome, but he did! During this time Ray rededicated his

life to Jesus Christ and concentrated on changing his life for the better. Ray left the real estate industry and took a job in January, 2019 with the Renewal by Andersen Window Company in their San Antonio Office. Ray's real estate knowledge and building construction made him a perfect fit for this position. Ray worked tirelessly making use of his construction knowledge and was awarded The 2019 Sales Achievement Two Million Club Award from Renewal by Andersen, with the third highest sales record in the country. Amazing Exteriors, i.e., Uncle Gary, and cousins Chris, Stephen, and Jason, met with him in February, 2020, regarding a move to work with them. In May, 2020, after the closure on his house was finalized, Ray joined Amazing Exteriors and was quickly promoted to Regional Sales Manager for their Dallas, Austin and San Antonio offices. He was so happy to be working with his family, doing what he loved. During a sales meeting in Redstone, Colorado, he called his Mother stating that he had trained for this his job his whole life. He loved working for Amazing Exteriors, that it felt like coming home. He felt as though his life had come full circle and he was where he was supposed to be.

Ray is preceded in death by his father, Kenneth Giles; his grandparents, James and Mary Louise Warrington and Charles Sherman Giles, and Uncle, Richard J. Warrington. He is survived by his daughters Kennedy Giles and Madison Giles; his Mother, Barbara Giles and brothers Chase S. Giles and G. Waine White, Jr.; sister-in-laws Jaclyn Giles and Emily White; Uncle Gary Warrington and Aunt Dorothy (Dot) Warrington; First cousins Jennifer Warrington, Jeff Warrington, Chris Warrington, John Warrington, Stephen Warrington, Julie Warrington, and Jason Warrington; Nieces Madelyn Giles, Josephine Giles, and Brielle Giles, and Isabella White; and Nephews Braedon Giles and Kenner White; and Godson, Roman Haynes, along with many, many loving friends.
