Raymond A. Hengst went to be with the Lord on July 25, 2022, at the age of 89 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on August 16, 1932, in Yorktown, Texas to Herman and Milda Hengst. He is preceded in death by his parents, sister Hermina Koepke, brother Alton Hengst.

Raymond is survived by his loving wife of 63 years Shirley Hengst and his children Debra L. Hengst and Gary R. Hengst, (Marlinda) and granddaughter Jackie Emma Rae Hengst, and sister Shirley Wolff.

Raymond joined the US Air Force in 1954 serving four years during the Korean Conflict War. He was a member of Hermann Sons Harmonia Grand Lodge for 69 years. Raymond was employed by S.W.R.I. for 30 years as a welder and assisted in the chemistry lab.

He was an avid trail ride member participating in several rides over the years spending many a night under the stars, just him and his horse awaking to the trail boss playing the "Cattle Call" and the smell of coffee and bacon as it cooked in the Dutch oven. His favorite time of the year was the fall looking forward to sitting in the blind waiting for a trophy deer to walk down the

Sendero as the sun was rising. He did enjoy fishing especially saltwater when he got the chance.

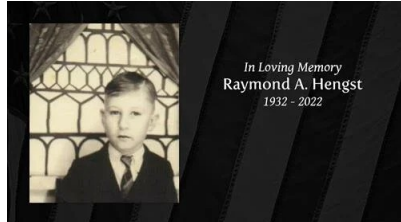

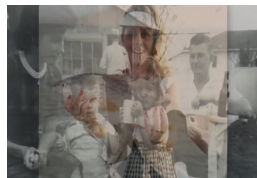
