Raymond Lloyd Icke, age 73, passed away on Tuesday, January 15, 2013, in San Antonio, Texas. Born in San Antonio to Conrad and Angela Icke on July 12, 1939, Ray graduated from Burbank High School in 1957. He served in the U.S. Navy and earned a Bachelor of Science in Physics from St. Mary's University.
