



## Raymond McDaniel Tripp

July 26, 1932 - June 27, 2023

Raymond McDaniel Tripp, was born in San Benito, Texas, on July 26, 1932, to Marshall and Edith Gertrude Tripp. He was the fourth of eight children. At the age of 5 years, he and his family moved to Brownsville, Texas. In 1953, he was drafted into the Army as a conscientious objector. While in the Military, he worked as a mechanic and was later transferred to the Medical Division as an Army medic. While serving he was wounded and was sent to San Antonio, Texas, for treatment, which later resulted in Honorable Medical Discharge from the Army.

San Antonio, became Raymond's permanent home as well as, where he met his wife of 51 years, Maxine. He achieved his Bachelor's from A & M Kingsville and his Master's from St. Mary's University and spent the next 35 years as a Social Worker for the State of Texas and in service to others. When he was not working Raymond, cared for his siblings, spent time with his favorite cats Liz and Frosty, and enjoyed hobbies of fixing cars, farming and driving his treasured white truck.

Raymond was preceded in death by his loving wife Maxine, his brothers Marshall, Elden and Jimmy and his sister Lenore. He is survived by his sons Richard McDaniel Tripp and his wife Denise, and by Christopher Raymond Tripp,. He is also survived by his brother Robert Tripp from Washington State, and his brother Donald Tripp and sister Barbara Tripp in San Antonio.

Raymond was a dedicated Jehovah's Witnesses and passed with the peace of knowing that he would have everlasting life through Jehovah and Jesus through the hope of the resurrection.
