Rebecca Suzanne Watren, lovingly known as Becky, passed away on March 14, 2026, at the age of 65. Becky was born on July 23, 1960, in Hondo, Texas. She was preceded in death by her parents, Richard S. Miller and Dorothy Eleanor (Ham) Miller.

Becky is survived by her beloved husband, Paul Joseph Watren Jr.; her brother, Ralph Samuel Miller; her loving in-laws; nieces and nephews; and many extended family members and dear friends who will carry her memory forward.

She will be remembered as a devoted wife, a loving sister and sister-in-law, a funny and warm-hearted aunt, and a loyal friend. Her presence brought comfort, laughter, and love to those around her, and she will be deeply missed.
