April 6, 1936 - April 13, 2025

Becky Davila Webb passed away peacefully on April 13, 2025, just one week after celebrating her 89th birthday. Born on April 6, 1936, in Robstown, Texas, Becky lived a life marked by compassion, service, and unwavering faith.

She graduated from McAllen High School in 1954 and went on to earn her nursing degree from Baptist Memorial Nursing School at Trinity University in 1957. Her dedication to caring for others led her to work as both an office and surgical nurse for two ENT surgeons. Becky later served as the very first Occupational Health Nurse for the United States Postal Service. She worked until her retirement in 1992. Her commitment to wellness and advocacy didn't end there—she continued serving in the same role for SAS Shoemakers until her second retirement in 2003.

Becky was married to William Walter Webb, Jr for 27 years. After his passing, she channeled her strong faith into mission work, making multiple trips to Peru through Salem Sayers Baptist Church—an experience that brought her great joy and purpose.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, William Walter Webb; her daughter, Janice Lynn Collier; her parents, Rev. Francisco F. Davila and Luz C. Davila; her stepson, William Walter Webb III; her brothers, Noe, Roman, Abram, and Elie Davila; her sisters, Maria Luz Lantz, Naomi Ferrero,

and Raquel D. Trevino; and her fiancé, Austin Foiles.

She is survived by her grandson, Jacob Michael Collier; her stepson and his wife, David & Elicia Webb; her stepdaughter and her husband, Melissa & Bill Littlefield; her stepdaughter Pennie DeVaney; her devoted nieces, Irma Garcia, Netty Saenz, Delia Turner, and Cecelia Fagan; and Austin's three children, Sean Foiles, Pennie Berk, and Regina Morris.
