René Ciro Espinosa died in Boerne, TX on April 9, 2026, at the age of 80. Born in Brownsville, TX on February 15, 1946, René was raised in Matamoros, Tamaulipas and Brownsville.

Lovingly known as “Memo,” his grandmother played an important role in raising René after the early loss of his mother. Her nurturing care left a lifelong impact on René. A proud graduate of Texas A&M University, he went on to serve for 20 years in the United States Air Force and then contracted as a civilian civil engineer. 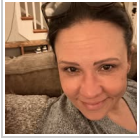

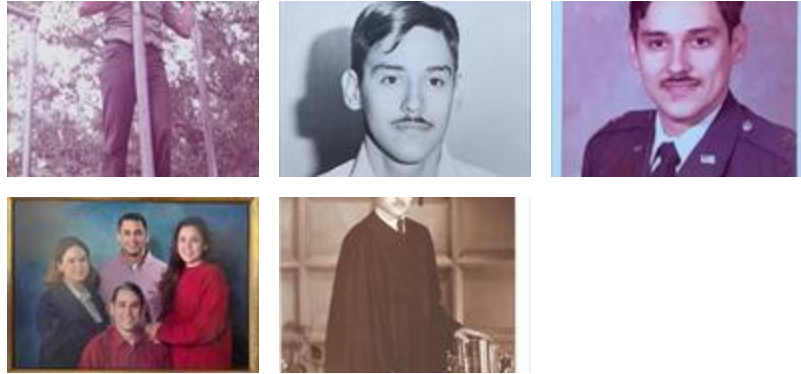
