



## Rev. C.T. Gray

November 6, 1922 - October 17, 2012

Rev C T Gray, age 89, of San Antonio, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, October 17, 2012. He was born on a farm in Gonzales, TX on November 6, 1922 to James Alfred and Katie Effie Gray. He was the youngest of 11 brothers and sisters. He went on to serve our country during WWII. He accepted Christ in 1947 and with his heart for people began pastoring in 1950 and continued until his retirement from Full Gospel Chapel in 1997. He preached a revival on the island of Cuba in 1960. Through FGC, he oversaw a rescue mission in downtown San Antonio in the 1970s, started a food and clothing program for the poor in the 1980s and built churches in Camargo and Hidalgo, Mexico. Over the years he was also involved in numerous businesses including The Chuckwagon Restaurant in downtown San Antonio and The Federated Vocational School. He had breakfast at McDonalds most every morning for over 20 years. He loved the news and closely followed politics. He had a warm and ready smile and never met a stranger. He was beloved by his family and friends and will be greatly missed and never forgotten. He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Ann Gray; sons, Marc Gray and Vernon Gray; 8 grandchildren, 3 great grandchildren and 1 great great grandchild. He was preceded in death by his daughter Vernie Jo Wagner and his granddaughter Marcia Gray.
