



Reynaldo Lozano "Lou"

Reynaldo Lozano, which many recognize as Lou, 77, passed away Wednesday, October 5th, 2016 at the VA hospital following a long battle with chronic illnesses.

He leaves behind his wife of 32 years, Maria Lozano, four daughters Mary Lozano, Martha Fimbrez with her husband (Daniel Fimbrez), Andria Lozano-Scott, and Nancy Rodriguez, a son Jose Rodriguez with his wife (Iris Rodriguez) , 11 grandchildren, 5 great-grandchildren, and many close friends.
