June 10, 1928 – December 4, 2017

God, family and country was the mantra that drove retired U.S. Air Force Staff Sergeant Reynaldo Ovalle, Sr., who went to be with his heavenly father on Monday, Dec. 4, 2017, at the age 89.

Ovalle imparted the importance of faith and daily prayer to his blended family.

He is preceded in death by wife Dolores Flores, son Robert Ovalle, and second wife Frances Lopez. He is survived by children Reynaldo Ovalle, Jr., Dolores Ovalle Medellin, Irene T. Ovalle-Flores, Gail Ovalle Adams, and Cynthia G. Martinez, eight grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

Ovalle Sr. served in the Army Air Corps from 1946-49, enlisting at age 17, requiring his mother's signature to join the military. He re-enlisted in 1951 and served his country for 22 years, including a 1970 tour in Da Nang, Viet Nam, alongside son, Rey Ovalle, Jr.

His first tour was in Saigon (1964-65).

Following his retirement in 1973, Ovalle, Sr., was involved with Disabled American Veterans, Chapter 25; and served with the Fort Sam Houston

National Cemetery Memorial Service Detachment for 20 years.
