Richard George Danko was born on September 28th, 1927 to Andrew and Agnes Menczynski Danko in Hazelton, Pennsylvania and passed away on June 15, 2016 in San Antonio, Texas. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Irene Ann Danko, and his three children: Susan Danko Stevenson Robert, Mimi Danko Burch Larry, and Richard Danko Sylvia; his grandchildren: Kelly Flessner Kyle, Robb Stevenson Courtney, Joshua Burch Carly, Cara Burch, Zack Burch, Nate Danko, Colin Danko Mary, and Anna Danko; and his great-grandchildren: Avery Flessner, Erin Flessner, Hailey Burch, and Brinley Burch. A lifelong musician, Richard played the violin since childhood and the French horn at university. He was also a talented athlete who earned a football scholarship at the University of Scranton. He graduated from University Scranton in 1952 with a Bachelors in Education and received a M.A. in Guidance and Counseling from Villanova University in 1960.

He served in the U.S Coast Guard from 1946 to 1948, worked with Keeler Boiler Company from 1948 to 1958, and was employed by the Devereux Foundation from 1958 to 1982. Richard was the Director of the Devereux School in Victoria, Texas from 1961 to 1978. He retired in 1982 to Boerne, Texas where he was a member of the choir, Knights of Columbus, and ACTS at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church.
