Richard B. Dick Squilla, passed away on Sunday, February 28, 2016, in San Antonio, TX at the age of 82, following a brief battle with cancer. The son of Joseph and Eleanor Lovine Squilla — first-generation Italian-Americans — Dick was born in Lodi, NJ on July 19, 1933. In 1954, he married Marie Rosato, and together they moved to San Antonio, where they raised four children. A devoted husband and father, Dick gave generously of his time to his children, whether through coaching CYO baseball or providing career advice. Traveling was his favorite pastime with Marie. Dick spent 35 years with Alamo Title Company, during which time he was part of a team that was instrumental in several significant commercial real estate developments in the 70s and 80s.
