Robert graduated from Louisiana State University in 1954 and entered the United States Air Force. He achieved the rank of full Colonel and served 27 years with distinctions and honors.

After retiring in 1982 from the USAF, he began a second successful career as an insurance agent for United Services Life. He retired in 1988 to help care for his mother-in-law in his home.

He was a devoted and active member of University United Methodist Church. He and his wife volunteered as Blue Birds for 25 years at Methodist Hospital in San Antonio.
