Robert M. Arthur was born on 21 July 1924, in Winchester, Indiana. He passed away on 19 Jan 2008, after an eight year fight against cancer. He was raised in an orphanage until he went to work hauling goods long distance. He joined the Army when 17 and married Wanda Lee Barnes while home on leave. He served in the Army/Air Force during the World War II, Korea and Vietnam War periods, retiring as a CMSgt in 1964. He then spent the next 22 years working for the USPS. Upon retiring from the post office, he went to work for his church and after retiring from that job, started his own business, working until two years ago. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints having served as Stake Mission President, Bishop and High Councilor and other callings. One of his favorite sayings was "it doesn't matter who gets the credit as long as the work gets done." He was preceded in death by his grandson, Joshua McSweeney. He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Wanda, and five daughters and two sons: Robert L. Arthur and wife Tamara, Judy Vogt and husband Ronald, Sherril Arthur, Deborah VanDeventer and husband Wilfred III, Nancy Strickland and husband Michael, Tina Arthur and R. Joseph Arthur.
