Beloved husband, father and grandfather, Robert T. Bordelon, went to be with our Lord July 16 after a long battle with cancer. He was born in San Antonio, June 25, 1938. Bob lived an honorable life as a RE/MAX Real Estate Agent, a banker and an engineer.
