



## Robert Stanley Boswell

June 11, 1919 - May 30, 2015

Robert Stanley Boswell, age 95 passed from this life on Saturday, May 30, 2015.

Robert was born in El Paso, Texas on June 11, 1919. Boz, as he was affectionately called, married Thelma Humble Boswell in 1946. They were married 47 years until her death in 1993.

He was a highly decorated pilot while serving in the China-Burma-India Theater during WWII.

He and the family resided in Venezuela for 10 years while employed by Creole Petroleum Corporation, an affiliate of Exxon. Returning to the U.S, he became Manager of Crane Company USA in San Antonio, and later President of PMI from 1981 to 1990.

In 1997 he married Ruth Lord Hite. They enjoyed 4 years together traveling extensively until her death in 2001.

Survivors include a daughter, Deborah Kuehn and husband, Robert Wayne Kuehn; grandchildren, Gentry Kuehn and Jourdan Kuehn and wife, Lacey; great grandchildren Kayleigh and Colton; a brother-in-law; nieces and nephews.
