Robert "Bud" Eibon born January 1st, 1927 in Superior, Wisconsin, joined The Lord on October 24th, 2014. He is survived by his loving wife Anne, married for sixty three years, and three children Ken Eibon, Diane Day, and Jeanne Sarmiento, in-laws, Roberto Sarmiento, Doug DeMars, Kathy French, as well as seven grandchildren and five great grandchildren. His daughter, Sharon DeMars, preceded him in death.
