Robert Dan Buie died peacefully at home surrounded by family and friends on March 9, 2007, just one week shy of his 60th birthday, after a long and hard fought battle with cancer. He was born in El Centro, California to Chester and Jessie Buie on March 16, 1947. After graduating from high school, he joined the US Air Force where he served his country proudly. First and foremost, Bob was a lumberman with a long and lustrous career that began in the early 1970's and encompassed all facets of the building industry. Bob served as owner and CEO of Buie Lumber Company in Boerne and had just recently celebrated the business' 20th anniversary.
