Robert Graham Ezzell, age 84, of Bulverde, Texas, passed away on December 7, 2025, at home surrounded by his family.

Robert was born at home in San Antonio, Texas, to Clyde Graham Ezzell and Hattie Allene Garrett, on July 8, 1941. He went to Brackenridge High School. After high school, he joined the U.S. Navy, where he worked in the engine room and spent lots of time in Bermuda, a place he always said had the most beautiful beaches he'd ever seen.

He worked as a salesman for Lawson Products for 30 years. After retiring from Lawson, he started his second career, delivering mail for the Spring Branch Post Office, where he made lots of great friends and was loved by all. He was known to step up and help the new mail carriers finish their routes when they got behind, and he kept everyone in the post office entertained with his quick sense of humor.

Robert, also lovingly referred to as Bob, Bobby, Daddy, Grandpa, Pampaw, Uncle Bob, and even Blobert, depending on who was talking to him, is probably best known for his love of life and great sense of humor. He never met a stranger anywhere he went, and he always had a new joke to tell when you saw him.

Every year on his birthday, he was as excited as a kid, eager to tell the

waitress, “It’s my birthday” because he loved it when they’d come sing to him, and he’d usually sing along with them. In his later years, he’d jokingly tell everyone that his birthday suit was getting wrinkled. He had such a positive outlook on life, no matter what. He was always the first to point out a beautiful sunset or a rainbow in the sky.

He loved music, especially the oldies, and was an excellent dancer. He instilled that love of music in both of his daughters, but only one of them inherited the dancing gene. He loved to spoil Luanne with jewelry and sweet love notes. They were the couple that always held hands, even after 60 years of marriage.

Robert is survived by his loving wife of 60 years, Alice Luanne Ezzell, and his daughters, Shari Bligh (James) and Tami Wolff (Charles), as well as his grandchildren, Lauryn, Jonathon, and Sofie. He is also survived by his siblings, John Ezzell (Rhonda), Melody Bellino, and Sandra Fuchs (Jeff), as well as seven nephews and one niece.
