He spoke of his love and devotion for his wife, Cheri, the love of his life for 43 years since they were teenage sweethearts, and how his illness has brought them closer together and made them stronger. He would tell others to love your spouse with your whole heart, every day!

He found such joy whenever he spent time at RiverSong, the family legacy property in Colorado.

He continued to witness to others, which gave him strength and energy, to the very end of his journey here on Earth.
