Robert Charles Lee passed away on May 9, 2007 at the age of 87. Robert was born in Smithville, Texas and graduated from Smithville High School in 1937. After graduating from high school, he attended Sul Ross Univ. on a football scholarship. At the age of 21 he was drafted by the US Army. While he was in the Army, World War II broke out. When the US Air Force was created, he moved to that branch of the service. He served in the US Air Force for 21 years. While in the Air Force, he served as an aircraft engineer, instructor, command pilot, and attained the rank of Major. As with many servicemen, he was stationed throughout the world. In the US, he was stationed in Texas, Florida and New York. Overseas he was stationed in Japan, Korea, Germany and Holland. He retired while stationed in New York and returned to San Antonio, Texas. In San Antonio, he worked for Heusinger Hardware for numerous years and retired from them. Robert was preceded in death by his sister, Francis Shafer and brothers, Hugh Lee and Randolph Lee. Robert was married for 65 years to his wife, Martha.
