Robert Charles Lucas, 81, died on April 17, 2015. "Bob" Lucas, son of Thomas and Emma, is survived by Carol, his spouse of 55 years, his brother, Thomas and his sister-in-law Doris, his children, Leslie Don, Laurie Charles, and Andrew, and numerous nieces and nephews.
