



Robert Rosales Osuna, Sr.

January 31, 1923 - February 23, 2021

Robert R. Osuna was called home by the Lord February 23, 2021. He was born January 31, 1923. His life would begin in rural areas including Yoakum, Texas. He was educated through the third grade. He would eventually further teach himself how to read and write. The Stock Market crash of 1929 devastated rural America. As a young man in his early teens (13 or so) , Robert learned to travel by train throughout the country seeking employment. Over time he enlisted in the Civilian Conservation Corp that provided a source of employment and he would take part in the construction of national parks. He was involved in the construction of the elevator shafts at Carlsbad Caverns New Mexico. He would then enlist in the United States Army Infantry as a teenager (17), partake in infantry and marksman training and the military boxing sport/ units as well, and eventually take part in the WWII war effort in Normandy. Robert suffered war injuries including head, hip and leg injuries and learned to walk again over a period of time. Robert would then learn to overcome traumatic war experiences and adopt to post war life without the medical aid afforded current veterans. He would remain gainfully employed his entire life, with the aid of the Good Lord, and his personal discipline, war time grit and determination. After the war effort, Robert then married Patsy Osuna and remained so for 72 years. He is survived by his spouse, Patsy Osuna, and five children, Rachel, Blanche, Robert Jr. and Spouse Debbie, Carl, and Edward and Spouse Nina. He was also blessed with 7 Grandchildren and 11 Great Grandchildren. He was a strong and loving father, grandfather, and

great grandfather. "This we'll Defend" (The Official motto of U.S. Army).

Funeral service will be held on Monday, March 8, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. at Mission Park Funeral Park South. Interment to follow at Mission Burial Park South.
