Robert Beverly Rust was born October 21, 1915 in Del Rio, Texas, the fourth child of parents Llewellyn and Margaret Fry Rust, both of whom preceded him in death. He passed away on September 23, 2007 in San Antonio, Texas at the age of 91 years, 11 months and 2 days. He and Janiearle moved to San Antonio in 1942 and have made their residence there since. He was a member of the Northwest Church of Christ at the time of his death. In addition to a large family which he loved very much, and loved him in return, Bev has an extensive array of friends and acquaintances, and his ever present smile was a trademark that all have loved and will miss very much. Bev lived an active life for most of his years, enjoying time with his beloved Janiearle, his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren, golf, travel, sports, hunting and just spending time in the

Hill country. He was a devoted Christian, and served in several leadership capacities in area churches over the years. He was a gifted encourager, and fully utilized the gifts which God gave him to enrich the lives of all who came into contact with him.
