He was a quiet and kind gentleman, holding the highest integrity in business and in family life. He was soft spoken and though it could be difficult to hear his stories, they were always worth the time and effort if you listened. He could never pass up a good deal and when anyone needed something, he usually had one on hand, though it would take him a little bit of time to find it. His daughter Andrea remembers him fondly as a “nerd” who had answers for nearly everything. He had a beautifully curious mind and you could often find him late into the night reading papers online.

His love for those around him was strong and warm and it was easy to see why he kept amazing friends, like Tony and Gerri, in his life for over 50 years. He enjoyed playing card games and he and Mary Ann would have friends like Tony and Gerri over; playing poker late into the night. The family remembers late nights playing games like Three-Thirteen and Tripoley.
