Robert (Bob) Trevino, born on June 3, 1947, went to be with the Lord on December 26, 2018 at the age of 71. Bob was born in San Antonio. He grew up in Los Angeles, where he attended and graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School. While at Wilson High, he was a city finalist in the gymnastics program for two years specializing in high bar and parallel bars.

Bob volunteered for the draft and served in the U. S. Army from October 1966 through September 1969, entering the Army as a Private and leaving as a First Lieutenant. While in the military, he was assigned to a unit in Korea that took control of a sector in the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ).

Bob moved to San Antonio in July 2009 to retire; however, when the economy took a severe downturn, his then-employer (Group X Financial) allowed him to continue as a Credit Manager working remotely from his home office in San Antonio until his ultimate retirement in July 2014. Although officially retired, he served on the Board of Directors as Treasurer for Finesilver Ranch Homeowner's Association, a position he held since 2015 until his death.

Bob is survived by his beloved wife Gloria Martha (Marthy) Trevino, to whom he's been married for 21 years and to whom he lovingly refers to as "The love of my life."

Bob is also survived by his son Jason Trevino (Annita); grandsons Christopher

and Nicholas; his brother Tom Trevino (Nancy); his sister Sylvia Schmidt (Herb); nephews Jeff Trevino and Eric Lundy; niece Karin Trevino and numerous wonderful cousins living throughout the United States.

Bob's favorite pastimes included golf, grilling and traveling to see family and friends.

Bob was loved by everyone who knew him and will be sorely missed for his warmth and loving personality.

Visitation will be held on Tuesday, January 8, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Mission Park Funeral Chapels North with the Funeral Service to begin at 12 p.m. Interment to follow at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery.
