Robert was a staunch supporter of Equal Right and helped from the San Antonio Chapter of the American Veterans for Equal Rights and was a marching member of the Wes Giles Memorial Color Guard which was attached to that same San Antonio Chapter. His leadership and caring were recognized by many as he helped homeless veterans transition from homelessness to a place in their communities. Always known for a gentle kiss and a raucous laugh, Robert will be missed by his San Antonio family and friends. To Robert, if you weren't family – he made you a part of his and he a part of yours.
