



## Roland Belk Jr.

September 22, 1941 - October 18, 2021

MSG Roland “Ronny” Belk, Jr., US Army (Ret.) passed away in San Antonio, Texas on October 18, 2021 at the age of 80. Ron was a highly decorated veteran in the US Marines and US Army who served over twenty years including two tours in the Vietnam War. Ron was born in San Antonio to parents Roland and Evelyn Belk. As a child in a military family, he lived in several states as well as in Japan and Germany. A talented baseball player, he pitched in the local and minor leagues. After graduating from Highlands High School, Ron joined the US Marines. In addition to Vietnam, he served his country in Okinawa, Turkey, Germany, and Nevada. His many service awards included the Purple Heart, two Bronze Stars and a Joint Service Commendation. After retiring from the active military, Ron returned to San Antonio. When he wasn’t working, he had a passion for hunting and taking drives through the hill country with his wife. Ronny is survived by his wife Sandra Belk (24 years), children Ricci Dunn (Shawn) and grandson Hayden, of Dripping Springs, Texas; Amber Clay (Brandon), Jeffrey Ryan, Briana Roberto (Azi), and Brenee Mora, all of San Antonio. He is also survived by siblings Larry Belk (Lynn) of Jacksonville, TX, Danny Belk (Deana) of Temple, TX, Gary Belk (Sue) of Marietta, GA, and Janet Shull (Clinton) of Schertz, TX, along with numerous nieces and nephews. There will be a memorial service on November 17, 2021 at 12 o’clock at the Dellcrest Funeral Home, followed by interment at the Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery.

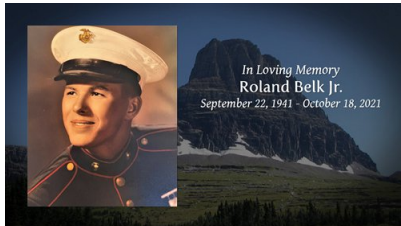

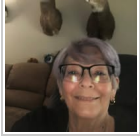
