



Roland Gerhard Dornes

October 1, 1927 - April 26, 2005

Roland Gerhard Dornes, 77 years old, passed away peacefully at home on Tuesday, April 26, 2005. Roland led a very adventurous and lucky life. He was born October 1, 1927 to Emma and Ernst Dornes in Bammental, Germany near Heidelberg. At 17, he was drafted into the German Army and was wounded and almost died in a Russian prison camp. After the war, he finished his schooling at the University of Heidelberg. In 1955, he came to the United States with an elite group of scientists as part of “Project Paperclip”, a government program that was known for advances in US space exploration. In 1959, Marianne, his German sweetheart, came to the U.S. by freighter, which docked in Brownsville, Texas. They were immediately married there upon her arrival. Roland became a U.S. citizen and worked at Brooks AFB for 33 years. After retiring from Brooks AFB in 1988, he established the first machine shop for the Engineering Department at UTSA, where he taught and worked for 5 years. Roland enjoyed many years of singing with the Beethoven Maennerchor where he will be greatly missed by a wide circle of friends. He especially enjoyed spending many happy hours with his three grandchildren. And through the years, he returned many times to his homeland, which he dearly loved. Roland is survived by his devoted wife of 46 years Marianne, his son Eric Dornes daughter-in-law Barbara Dornes and granddaughter Kara Dornes, daughter Christina Dornes-Ermlich son-in-law Christian Ermlich, granddaughter Julia Ermlich and grandson Alexander Ermlich, and by his brother Dieter Dornes, sister-in-law Fritzi Dornes and niece Ulrike, all from

Weinheim, Germany. A special thank you is extended to all his nurses from the hospice service at Christus Santa Rosa for their loving care. Thanks especially for all thoughts and prayers from loving friends and family.
