Ronald "Ronnie" R. Guzman, born February 5, 1947 in San Antonio, Texas, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, June 14, 2014. He was preceded in death by his parents Rudolph and Eva Guzman and brother Richard Guzman. He is survived by his brother Rodolfo Guzman Jr. and wife Mary Helen; his niece, Celeste Guzman Mendoza and husband Michael; and his nephew René A.
